Text Isaiah 53:1-12


Theme: The Messiah came as the suffering Servant, bearing our sins, dying in our place, and bringing salvation to all who will receive Him.

 - All we like sheep have gone astray. V.6
 - His silent submission established our salvation. V.7
- III. The lamb who _____ is Messiah. V.10-12
- It pleased the Lord to crush Him, for our sake. V.10
 - He will see His offspring, in the resurrection. V.10
 - He justifies many; all who will believe. V.11
 - He receives the victor’s reward; faith is our victory. V.12


